The Airports Economic Regulatory Authority (AERA), has issued an Addendum to their Order No. 25/2017-18 dated 30.11.2017 regarding Aeronautical Tariffs for Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport, Nagpur for the 1<sup>st</sup> Control period 01.04.2016 – 31.03.2021 (Copy enclosed).

2. These charges shall come into effect on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 in the manner prescribed by AERA.

**In the matter of determination of aeronautical tariffs in respect of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport, Nagpur for the first control period (01.04.2016-31.03.2021).**

1. The Authority vide Order no. 25/2017-18 dated 30.11.2017 determined the tariffs in respect of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport, Nagpur for the first control period effective from 16.12.2017.

2. Subsequent to the issue of Order, it is noticed that the clause on Collection Charges is omitted in Tariff Card. Hence the following clauses are added to Notes to UDF:

2.1 Collection Charge: If the payment is made within 15 days of receipt of invoice then collection charges at ₹ 5 per departing passenger shall be paid by MIL. No collection charges shall be paid in case the airline fails to pay the UDF invoice to MIL within the credit period of 15 days or in case of any part payment. To be eligible to claim this collection charges, the airlines should have no overdue on any account with MIL. Wherever collection charges are payable the amount shall be settled within 15 days.

2.2 No collection charges are payable to casual operator/non-scheduled operators

2.3 No UDF will be levied for Transit Passengers

**ORDER**

3. The Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, and the facts and clarifications placed on record before the Authority, decides and orders that :

**The clause at Para 2.1 to 2.3 above may be read with notes to User Development Fees (UDF) of Tariff Card.**

**Further the collection charge on PSF (SC) as specified by the Govt. of India may be followed, which is presently @ 2.5% of PSF.**
