## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

26th September 2014

With the revision of Rule 61, the AME licenses are required to be issued as per the requirements laid down in CAR 66. The implementation of said Rule was deferred till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014 due to administrative reasons.

It has now been decided by the competent authority that the process needs to be completed in phased manner and without extending the implementation date. As per the programme charted out, the licenses for AMEs employed with scheduled airlines will be undertaken in first phase, AMEs employed with Non Scheduled operators in second phase and remaining AMEs will be taken up in third phase.

For this purpose, regional offices have been directed to obtain the applications from individuals working with the scheduled airlines. The applications shall be duly verified by the concerned officials in the respective organizations. Consolidated information in respect of each organisation shall also be submitted by the airline in the MS Access data sheet as soft copy, available with the regional offices.

The Regional/Sub-regional Offices shall forward data along with applications for conversion of existing type rated AMEs under their jurisdiction. The data should be forwarded to headquarters as per the following schedule:
